For Accredited Veterinarians: Electronic signature ACCEPTED

For APHIS VMO: Digital endorsement ACCEPTED

USDA-accredited veterinarians can electronically issue health certificates and use VEHCS (Veterinary Export Health Certification System) to submit them to USDA for digital endorsement.

USDA can digitally endorse the health certificate and return it electronically.

Live Animal Export Country Requirements

Import licenses are required for all animals entering Indonesia.

The permit should be obtained from:

Director General of Livestock and Animal Health Services cq Director of Animal Health, Ministry of Agriculture, Building C, 9th floor, Jl. Harsono RM no. 3, Pasar Minggu, Jakarta 12550 Indonesia

Summary of Requirements

Note: Indonesia is currently requiring cats, minks, ferrets, tigers, lions, Golden Syrian Hamsters, bats, and all primates (regardless of pet, or other purpose) to be accompanied with a negative laboratory result for a PCR COVID-19 (SARS-CoV-2) test that occurred prior to export. All other live animals (dogs, production animals and genetics) do not require a COVID-19 test prior to export.
