Poultry

For industry members needing to evaluate trade restriction zones, routes of travel, and generate maps, the Veterinary Services Trade Route Mapping Tool has been developed to support these processes. Note: Due to detection of highly pathogenic avian influenza (HPAI) in the United States, the following model certificates for poultry may not be able to be endorsed: Hatching eggs, Day-old Chicks, Poultry LT20. Contact the relevant <u>Veterinary Export Trade Services (VETS)</u> <u>Endorsement Office</u> if there is any question about restrictions on a specific shipment. Model SPF is not affected.

If your species is not listed, the requirements for that species are not known. Exporters who want to ship livestock or germplasm whose requirements are not listed above should have the importer or buyer in the destination country apply for an import permit at the appropriate ministry. This import permit will most likely outline the specific requirements.
