### APHIS Definitions

**\*Additional restrictions on the import of this commodity apply. See the APHIS website for additional information.**

**Bovine:** *Bos taurus*, *Bos indicus*, and *Bison bison* (domestic cattle, bison)

**Bovid:** All members of the family Bovidae, including domestic cattle, bison, water buffalo, yak, and related species

**Cervid:** All members of the family Cervidae and hybrids, including deer, elk, moose, caribou, reindeer, and related species

**Camelid:** All species of the family Camelidae, including camels, guanacos, llamas, alpacas, and vicunas

**Prohibited:** The importation of this commodity is banned by Federal regulations.

**Not Currently Allowed:** The importation of this commodity is not currently allowed due to other foreign animal diseases of concern in the country of origin, the lack of a negotiated or updated import protocol, or the lack of a negotiated export health certificate from the country of origin. **Allowed:** The importation of this commodity is permitted.

**FMD:** Foot-and-mouth disease

**CSF:** Classical swine fever

**ASF:** African swine fever

**BSE:** Bovine spongiform encephalopathy
