# **California's *Lilioceris lili*/ Lily leaf beetle Program approved by APHIS Under the Federally Recognized State Managed Phytosanitary (FRSMP) Program**

APHIS' Plant Protection and Quarantine (PPQ) is recognizing California's FRSMP program for *L. lili*/Lily leaf beetle. This is the second State-managed phytosanitary program to be recognized in California.

If *Lilioceris lili* (Scopoli) Lily leaf beetle is detected in imported goods, shipments will be prohibited entry to California. The importer has the option to voluntarily treat, re-export, redirect, or destroy the shipment. This is equivalent to restrictions imposed by the State of California when Lily leaf beetle is detected in interstate movement.
