APHIS updated the <u>Federal Domestic Soil Quarantines Map</u> to include the following changes:

- Expanded the European Cherry Fruit Fly Quarantine to include all of Cayuga County, New York
- Expanded the European Cherry Fruit Fly Quarantine to include all of Genese County, New York
- Removed the Oriental Fruit Fly Quarantine in Sacramento County, California

APHIS restricts the movement of domestic soil from areas within the continental United States that are under quarantine for specific plant pests. The Federal Domestic Soil Quarantines Map provides an overview of the plant pest quarantines that affect the movement of soil.
