Veterinary (Health) certificate for dog chews intended for dispatch to or for transit through Georgia [3(C) equivalent]

To be eligible for this certificate, a facility must be listed for [and the materials must meet the requirements of] the Regulation 142/2011 as amended "CHAPTER 3(C) Health certificate for dog chews intended for dispatch to or for transit through the European Union".

For the purposes of this certificate, "dog chews" defined as products for pet animals to chew, produced from untanned hides and skins of ungulates or from other materials of animal-origin. Therefore, use of this document is not limited to only chews for dogs.
