Don't Send Fresh Fruits and Vegetables to the U.S. Mainland. **It's the law!**



Fresh fruits and vegetables may carry agricultural pests or diseases.

Commodities that are permitted:

- Treated fruit in sealed boxes with a U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) treatment stamp
- Cut flowers in sealed boxes with a USDA limited permit stamp
- Pineapples, after USDA inspection
