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**Certification Statements :**

I, the undersigned USDA Accredited Veterinarian, certify that:

2.1. The United States of America (US) is free of contagious bovine pleuropneumonia, foot-and-mouth disease and rinderpest.

2.2. The bovine semen originated from premises that are:

2.2.1. under the supervision of a USDA accredited veterinarian;

2.2.2. free of clinical signs of bovine genital campylobacteriosis, bovine genital trichomoniasis, bovine viral diarrhea, brucellosis, enzootic bovine leukosis, infectious bovine rhinotracheitis, leptospirosis, paratuberculosis (Johne's disease) and tuberculosis, for the 6 months prior to semen collection;

2.2.3. free of clinical signs of anthrax for the 20 days prior to embryo collection; and

2.2.4. not under official quarantine for the control of contagious animal diseases.

2.3. The donor bulls:

2.3.1. were resident in the semen collection center for at least 6 months prior to semen collection;

2.3.2. were not used for natural mating;

2.3.3. were examined at the time of semen collection and were free from clinical symptoms of infectious diseases including bovine genital campylobacteriosis, bovine genital trichomoniasis, bovine viral diarrhea, brucellosis, leptospirosis and tuberculosis;

2.3.4. were negative to tests for the following diseases within 6 months prior to or 6 months after semen collection for export (specify date and nature of test):

2.3.4.1. bovine genital campylobacteriosis \_\_\_\_\_

2.4. To the best of the knowledge of the certifying veterinarian, the semen is free from contamination of pathogenic microorganisms. The semen was examined microscopically and no evidence of blood cells was found.
