

Addendum to Health Certificate for Temporary Export of Horses to the European Union Intended for Re-export to Canada in Less Than 60 Days

Certification Statements:

The horse(s) must be certified for Contagious Equine Metritis (CEM) as follows:

i) The horse(s) has/have not been on a premises where *T. equigenitalis* has been isolated during the sixty (60) days immediately preceding exportation to Canada or a premises currently under quarantine or investigation for CEM. Any female(s) in the shipment have not been bred naturally to or inseminated with semen from a stallion positive for CEM, or a stallion resident upon a positive premises or under quarantine or investigation for CEM.

ii) The horse(s) showed no clinical signs of CEM on the day of inspection.

For U.S. horses entering Canada after a stay of less than 60 days in the European Union, this addendum must be presented with the original U.S. export health certificate upon entry to Canada from the European Union. This addendum is not needed for entry to the European Union and should not be presented upon entry to the European Union.
