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**Certification Statements:**

The undersigned USDA accredited veterinarian hereby certifies the following:

1. The United States of America (U.S.A.) officially confirms that commercial poultry flocks are free from highly pathogenic Avian Influenza, velogenic viscerotropic Newcastle disease. The export pet bird has been born or raised in the U.S.A. for at least the previous 6 months.

2. Before being exported, the pet bird was isolated for at least 30 days at a place approved by a USDA accredited veterinarian.

3. During the isolation, a clinical examination and testing was conducted at \_\_\_\_\_ (laboratory name), and the results were negative. (Remove or mark through any option not used)

1) Avian influenza:

a) Hemagglutination inhibition test (H5, H7); or ELISA

Note: HI test will be determined as positive when titer is 1:16 or above

2) Newcastle Disease: (This test can be exempted if vaccinated for Newcastle Disease)

a) Hemagglutination inhibition test

Note: HI test will be determined as positive when titer is 1:16 or above

OR

b) Cloacal swabs: Virus Isolation or PCR test;

3) Psittacosis (Parrot Fever)

a) AGID or Complement fixation or ELISA test;

4. The pet bird for export will be examined within 24 hours prior to departure and found to be free from any symptoms of infectious diseases.

5. All cages for transporting the bird will be properly sanitized with disinfectant \_\_\_\_\_ (product listed) approved by the official authority of the export country or area.

6. During the transportation, the export bird shall not contact any birds from a different consignment.

7. Provide a list of vaccinations and antiparasitic treatments as an attachment. Include name and type of product (i.e. modified live or killed vaccine, anthelmintic, etc) manufacturer, dose, and date of administration.
