Standard Operating Procedure for Import of Equine(s):

Pre-Arrival Requirements:

- 1. Minimum 07 days before embarkation, the application form (Annexure 3.1) will be submitted through Email by the applicant.
- After examining the uploaded forms, Advance No Objection certificate (NOC (Annexure 3.2)) will be issued by the concerned Animal Quarantine and Certification Services within 1 working day.

On Arrival at the Port of Entry

1. The Equine(s) will be taken to the Quarantine Station and will remain under quarantine for 30 days.

During Quarantine Period at AQCS

- Everyday examination record (Annexure 3.3) will be maintained and testing reports (against Dourine, AHS, EVA, Glanders, EIA and CEM) will be updated online. CEM will be tested twice i.e., on 4th and 11th day. The applicant will bear the charges for testing.
- 2. Final NOC (Annexure 3.4) will be issued in case negative test reports (as per Annexure 3.1.1) are obtained for the Equine(s) under quarantine.
- 3. In case of the positive testing reports, deportation will be done at the cost of owner. If Equine(s) dies, Post –Mortem and destruction will be done at the cost of owner.

*As per notification S.O. 1495(E), 10.06.2014, Live animals are allowed to be imported in Chennai, Kolkata, Mumbai and Delhi except for pet animals. *Complete clearance process is depicted at Annexure 3


