IV. Health Information:

I, the undersigned USDA Accredited Veterinarian, hereby certify that the said birds:

- (a) Are identified by closed leg-ring.
- (b) Were born and reared in the territory of the United States, or* have been resident in the United States for at least 45 days immediately prior to exportation.
- (c) Were kept for at least the recent 45 days prior to shipment to Israel in a country/zone/compartments (*) of origin free from Notifiable Avian Influenza (NAI) as defined in the Terrestrial Animal Health Code of the OIE.
- (d) Were kept for at least the recent 45 days prior to shipment to Israel in an area which in a radius of 10 km has been free from Newcastle Disease as defined in the Terrestrial Animal Health Code of the OIE.
- (e) Were kept in premises which have been free from Avian Influenza, Newcastle Disease and other Paramyxoviruses, Pullorum-Gallinarum Disease, Ornithosis-Psittacosis, Pox, and Pacheco Disease (for psittacine only) during at least the recent 45 days. No birds were introduced into the premises during this period.
- (f) *Were fed with chlortetracycline, 2.5 gms per kg of feed, for the 45 days before shipment to Israel between (date)_____ and (date)_____, or were given drinking water with chlortetracycline or doxycycline, 0.25 gms per liter of water, for the 45 days before shipment to Israel between (date)_____ and (date)_____, or were injected with at least 6 doses of doxycycline (Vibramycin) at the rate of not less than 75 mg per kg live-weight, once every 5 days, between (date)_____ and (date)_____, or* were tested negative for Psittacosis within 45 days prior to shipment (paragraph f may be deleted for passerine birds).
- (g) Have not been vaccinated against Paramyxoviruses and all types of Avian Influenza.
- (h) Were examined by me within 4 days prior to shipment and were found healthy and free from clinical signs or symptoms of infectious or contagious diseases.
- (i) Were caged in new, clean containers in compliance with international and IATA standards.
