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Certification Statements:

I, the undersigned USDA accredited veterinarian, certify the following:

1. The falcons for export have been examined within seven (7) days of departure and show no clinical signs of contagious or infectious diseases, including avian influenza and Newcastle disease.

2. Either the falcons for export were tested for avian influenza in a laboratory approved by APHIS within 30 days of departure and held in isolation since the time of testing (laboratory name, test method and test date of negative test are recorded on the tables below); OR originate from a U.S. state that is free of HPAI.

3. Either the falcons for export were tested for Newcastle disease in a laboratory approved by APHIS within 30 days of departure and held in isolation since the time of testing (laboratory name, test method and test date of negative test are recorded on the tables below); OR originate from a U.S. state that is free of Newcastle disease.

NOTE: The consignment will be shipped directly from the United States of America to the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia. In the event of any deviation in travel, the Saudi Ministry of Environment, Water and Agriculture shall be informed and assured that the falcons have not contacted with any other birds during transit.

NOTE: U.S. origin falcons for export are required to have an import permit issued by the Ministry of Environment, Water and Agriculture. That import permit must accompany the consignment.

NOTE: U.S. origin falcons must be accompanied by a CITES passport or any means of identification indicating the falcon's data, and meet all U.S. federal requirements for export of falcons by the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service, prior to departure.
