IMPORT HEALTH REQUIREMENTS OF THE BRITISH VIRGIN ISLANDS
FOR BIRDS OTHER THAN POULTRY EXPORTED FROM THE UNITED STATES

The animals must be accompanied by a U.S. Origin Health Certificate issued by a veterinarian authorized by the U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) and endorsed by a Veterinary Services (VS) veterinarian. The certificate shall contain the name and address of the consignor and consignee, and complete identification of the animals to be exported. Additional information shall include:

CERTIFICATION STATEMENTS

1. The bird was examined and found to be clinically healthy and free of infectious and contagious diseases.

OTHER INFORMATION

1. The Ministry may, at any time, prohibit the importation of birds of the parrot family from any country in which the Ministry has reason to believe there is an epidemic of psittacosis.
2. "Birds other than poultry" include parrots, Amazon Mexican double heads, African grays, cockatoos, budgerigars, macaws, parakeets, love birds, lories, lorikeets, canaries, finches, and sparrows.
