

## **Hydrolyzed Proteins for Purposes Other than Human Consumption**

Bosnia and Herzegovina require the bilingual “Veterinary health certificate for import into Bosnia and Herzegovina of hydrolysed protein, dicalcium phosphate and tricalcium phosphate not intended for human consumption to be used as feed material or for uses outside the feed chain” for the import of hydrolyzed proteins intended for purposes other than human consumption.

This certificate mimics the requirements of the Regulation (EC) 142/2011 (as amended) “CHAPTER 12 Health certificate For hydrolysed protein, dicalcium phosphate and tricalcium phosphate not intended for human consumption to be used as feed material or for uses outside the feed chain, intended for dispatch to or for transit through the European Union.” Prior to endorsement of the “Veterinary health certificate for import into Bosnia and Herzegovina of hydrolysed protein, dicalcium phosphate and tricalcium phosphate not intended for human consumption to be used as feed material or for uses outside the feed chain” the pertinent exporting/processing facilities must be approved by APHIS Veterinary Services for endorsement of the Regulation (EC) 142/2011 (as amended) “CHAPTER 12 Health certificate For hydrolysed protein, dicalcium phosphate and tricalcium phosphate not intended for human consumption to be used as feed material or for uses outside the feed chain, intended for dispatch to or for transit through the European Union.” For information on how to receive this required approval, a facility should contact the [Veterinary Services service center](#) covering the area where the facility is located.
