

Blood Products Exported to Croatia for Technical Purposes (Arriving Prior to July 1, 2013)

Blood products intended for technical uses (and arriving to Croatia prior to July 1, 2013) must be accompanied by the “VETERINARY CERTIFICATE FOR UNTREATED BLOOD PRODUCTS, EXCLUDING OF EQUIDAE, FOR THE MANUFACTURE OF DERIVED PRODUCTS FOR PURPOSES OUTSIDE THE FEED CHAIN FOR FARMED ANIMALS, INTENDED FOR DISPATCH TO OR FOR TRANSIT THROUGH(1) THE REPUBLIC OF CROATIA.”

These products must meet the requirements of the Regulation (EU) 142/2011 Chapter 4(C) certificate. The products must be exported from a facility approved by APHIS for the Regulation (EU) 142/2011 Chapter 4(C) certificate, and the products must meet the requirements of that approval and be eligible for export to the EU.

Sections II.1 through II.10 of the “VETERINARY CERTIFICATE FOR UNTREATED BLOOD PRODUCTS, EXCLUDING OF EQUIDAE, FOR THE MANUFACTURE OF DERIVED PRODUCTS FOR PURPOSES OUTSIDE THE FEED CHAIN FOR FARMED ANIMALS, INTENDED FOR DISPATCH TO OR FOR TRANSIT THROUGH(1) THE REPUBLIC OF CROATIA” must be lined out in accordance with the equivalent sections of the pertinent entry (by species of origin) at the following page under the European Union file:
