

Dairy for Human Consumption Products Transiting the European Union (EU)

- This document refers to products intended for human consumption that are only transiting the EU.
- All milk products except for those derived exclusively from caprine (goat) or ovine (sheep) milk must be heat-treated prior to export. (Bovine-origin raw milk products from the U.S. are not eligible to transit the EU at this time.)
- Products must also be accompanied by all certifications required by the pertinent government authorities of the final destination.
- APHIS-Veterinary Services (VS) endorsement of the “**ANIMAL HEALTH CERTIFICATE for milk and milk-based products, for [transit]/[storage] in the European Community**” certificate is required if the port of entry into the EU is in Belgium, the UK, or Ireland. Otherwise, AMS or VS may endorse this certificate. However, if AMS or VS endorsement of other certification is required by government authorities of the country of final destination, then that respective agency must provide this certification as part of one certificate for the consignment.

When preparing the certificate:

- Section 3.1: The ISO code and name of Country for the United States is as follows: ISO code: “US”. Name: “United States”.
- Section 3.2: The “Code of territory” for the United States is “US-0”.
- Line 9.2 must be completed as indicated below:

Option One: Heat-Treated Milk Products (Required for all products except for ovine/caprine origin products):

Or

Option Two: For ovine/caprine raw milk products (Only allowed when section 8.1 on the certificate notes **only** “ovine” and or “caprine.”)

“9.2 complies with the relevant animal health conditions for the products concerned as laid down in the animal health attestation in section 9 of the model certificates ~~[Milk-RM]~~ / ~~[Milk-RMP]~~ / ~~[Milk-HTB]~~ / ~~[Milk-HTC]~~⁽³⁾ in Part 2 of Annex II to Commission Decision [2004/438/EC*];”

- Line 9.3 may not be struck out and the blanks may not be completed.

- Line 9.4: The date (or date range) of production must be placed in the blank. Exporters must present affidavits supporting this statement (for the lots of products being exported) to the endorsing VS office with the certificate.

Note- all “cross-outs” must be initialed by the certificate endorser.

Notes

- (1) Milk and milk-based products means, heat-treated milk, milk-based products and raw milk for human consumption.
- (2) In accordance with Article 12 (4) or Article 13 of Council Directive 97/78/EC.
- (3) Keep as appropriate.
- (4) Issued by the competent authority.
- (5) Country and ISO code of the territory as appearing in Annex I to Commission Decision [2004/438/EC*] (as last amended).
- (6) Address (and approval number if known) of the warehouse in a free zone, free warehouse, customs warehouse or ship chandler shall be included.
- (7) Complete as appropriate.
- (8) The registration number(s) of rail-wagon or lorry and the name of the ship should be given as appropriate. If known, the flight number of the aircraft.
In case of transport in containers or boxes, the total number, their registration and seal numbers, if present, should be indicated under point 7.3.
- (9) Complete if appropriate.
- (10) Date or dates of production. Imports of the milk and milk-based products shall not be allowed when obtained either prior to the date of authorisation for exportation to the European Community from the territory mentioned under (3), or during a period where restrictive measures have been adopted by the European Community against imports of the milk and milk-based products from this territory.
- (11) The colour of the signature shall be different to that of the printing. The same rule applies to stamps other than those embossed or watermark.
