

Honduras - Important information regarding trade bans and other restrictions

Poultry products:

The government of Honduras has lifted import restrictions for poultry products have not been heat treated for the States of Oregon, Idaho, California, Montana, Washington, Arkansas, Kansas, Indiana, and North Dakota with an effective date of September 24, 2015.

While their poultry ban was not well described, it should be construed as affecting fresh (not heat treated) poultry products such as raw pet foods containing poultry, feathers, offal, egg yolks, and egg whites as well as poultry meat (except fully cooked, canned, commercially sterile products). Restrictions remain in place for the following States: Iowa, Missouri, Minnesota, South Dakota, Wisconsin and Nebraska.

An import permit is advised and should be requested for poultry products that have not been heat treated.
