Bovine-Bone Origin Gel Bone intended for “Pharmaceutical” Purposes

The government of Japan has verified that the following attestations are required on a VS Form 16-4 for bovine origin gel bone (rendered bone chips) imported for “pharmaceutical” purposes

Only the following attestations may appear on the VS Form 16-4:

This office has on file a notarized affidavit from [insert name of company here] verifying the accuracy of the statements below. I, the endorsing official listed below, have read the notarized affidavit referenced above, and to the best of my knowledge and belief these statements are true.

The products described below do not contain bovine skulls or vertebral column (excluding the vertebrae of the tail, the transverse processes of the thoracic and lumbar vertebrae, and the wings of the sacrum), from cattle. The products described below are U.S. origin and contain only those animal origin ingredients derived from animals that passed ante-mortem government inspection at slaughter.

Prior to endorsement, the Veterinary Services field office must have on file the following notarized affidavits signed annually:

- An affidavit from the gel bone producer (renderer) verifying not only that the products exported to Japan meet the above criteria (second paragraph in blue), but also listing the FSIS slaughter or processing plants supplying the rendering plant with the raw materials.
- An affidavit from each supplier listed on the above referenced affidavit verifying that the materials supplied to the renderer for Japan:
 - Do not contain bovine skulls or vertebral column (excluding the vertebrae of the tail, the transverse processes of the thoracic and lumbar vertebrae, and the wings of the sacrum), from cattle of any age; and
 - Contain only those animal origin ingredients derived from animals that passed ante-mortem government inspection at slaughter.
