

Jamaica - Important information regarding trade bans and other restrictions

Import Permits:

The importer must obtain an import permit issued by the Veterinary Services Division (VSD), Jamaica for entry of all animal products. The permit number must be reflected on the commercial documents (e.g. bill of lading, invoice) accompanying the shipment. Jamaica's VSD also requires that the shipment's VS Form 16-4 "Export Certificate for Animal Products" certificate number be listed on the commercial documents (ideally the invoice) accompanying the shipment.

Poultry products:

Jamaica has lifted previous bans for poultry meat and fresh poultry products, such as raw pet foods containing poultry, feathers, offal, egg yolks, and egg whites.
