

Certification Requirements for the Export of Unprocessed (Greasy) Camelid Hair to Peru

The bilingual certification statements provided below for the export of unprocessed (greasy) camelid hair to Peru should be made in the Additional Declaration section on a VS Form 16-4, Export Certificate for Animal Products, and continuation sheet as necessary.

Product description (product box on VS Form 16-4) should include the species of origin and the quantity of product being exported.

Please see asterisked * comment pertaining to verification of non tampering and requirement for a unique seal on the container.

Certification statements required on the VS form 16-4:

This office has on file a notarized affidavit from [insert company name] verifying the accuracy of the statements below: / *Esta oficina mantiene en archivos una declaración notariada de [nombre de la compañía] que verifica la certeza de las declaraciones de abajo:*

1. The product derives from animals born and raised in the exporting country. / *La mercancía procede de animales nacidos y criados en el país exportador.*
2. The product has been fumigated or disinfected using a chemical product and procedures approved in the United States as efficacious for the destruction of pathogenic organisms and arthropods. / *El producto ha sido fumigado o desinfectado utilizando productos químicos y procedimientos aprobados y reconocidos en los Estados Unidos para la eliminación de virus y artrópodos.*
3. The product has been identified with a unique seal on the container and the seal was intact at the time of export. / *Han sido empacados e identificados con un sello único en el contenedor y este sello se mantuvo intacto al momento de la exportación.*
4. Prior to shipment, transport vehicles were disinfected with approved products authorized by the United States. / *Antes de ser embarcados, los vehículos de transporte fueron desinfectados con productos autorizados por Estados Unidos.*

* A unique seal must be placed on the container and the seal number noted on the veterinary certificate.
