

## **Partially Treated Game Trophies Derived from Ungulates and/or Birds**

Serbia requires the bilingual *“Health certificate For treated game trophies and other preparations of birds and ungulates, consisting only of bones, horns, hooves, claws, antlers, teeth, hides or skins, for dispatch to or for transit through the Republic of Serbia (RS)”* for the import (or transit) of “game trophies and other preparations of birds and ungulates, consisting only of bones, horns, hooves, claws, antlers, teeth, hides or skins”.

This certificate mimics the requirements of the Regulation (EU) 142/2011 (as amended) *“CHAPTER 6(A) Health certificate For treated game trophies and other preparations of birds and ungulates, being solely bones, horns, hooves, claws, antlers, teeth, hides or skins, for dispatch to or for transit through the European Union”*.

Prior to endorsement of the *“Health certificate For treated game trophies and other preparations of birds and ungulates, consisting only of bones, horns, hooves, claws, antlers, teeth, hides or skins, for dispatch to or for transit through the Republic of Serbia (RS)”* the pertinent exporting/processing facilities must be approved by APHIS Veterinary Services for endorsement of the Regulation (EU) 142/2011 (as amended) *“CHAPTER 6(A) Health certificate For treated game trophies and other preparations of birds and ungulates, being solely bones, horns, hooves, claws, antlers, teeth, hides or skins, for dispatch to or for transit through the European Union”*.
