Controlled BSE Risk Countries with no reported cases of BSE: Safe commodities as defined by the OIE or those derived from cattle and bison which 1) passed AM inspection; and 2) which were not subjected to a stunning process, prior to slaughter with a device injecting compressed air or gas into the cranial cavity or to a pithing process; and ingredients were produced and handled in a manner to ensure they do not contain and are not contaminated with BSE risk materials and mechanically separated meat from the skull and vertebral column from cattle and bison over 30 months of age.

Controlled BSE Risk Countries with reported cases of BSE: Eligible bovine materials are the same as for Controlled BSE Risk Countries with no reported cases of BSE except bovine viscera is NOT eligible.

Undetermined BSE Risk Countries with no reported cases of BSE: Safe commodities as defined by the OIE only.

Undetermined BSE Risk Countries with reported cases of BSE: No bovine-derived materials are eligible.
