			APHIS waive any fee, including search and duplication costs. A fee waiver is appropriate where [d]isclosure of the requested information is in the public interest because it is likely to contribute significantly to public understanding of the operations or activities of the government [and] is not primarily in the commercial interest of the requester 7 C.F.R. § 1.12(p). Here, a fee waiver should be granted as disclosure is in the public interest, as furnishing the informat on is likely to contribute significantly to public understanding of the operations or activities of APHIS and disclosure is not in the ASPCA's commercial interest.
