### Nursery naming conventions

Use the Full Proper Business Name as is used for the mailing address of the company for all nurseries

- For large businesses with multiple locations and headquarters offices (i.e. Monrovia Nursery Company)
  - o Use the company’s method of distinguishing each location where possible (i.e. Store #212) at the end of the name
  - o Use IPHIS Hierarchy to tie individual locations back to a central location (i.e. Corp. Headquarters)
- For smaller businesses with multiple locations but no central headquarters
  - o If the business has an internal way of distinguishing store (i.e. Westside, Eastside) use that method at the end of the location name
  - o If the business has no designation method
    - Businesses with stores in multiple states/cities, use state/city at the end of the location name
    - Businesses with stores within the same city, use street name at the end of the location name
- Do not include program name, year or a person’s name or title as part of the location name
- If more than one business shares the same street address either use the suite number in the address or use the 9 digit postal code in the zip code field (i.e. 12345+6789). Do not include information beyond the business name in the location name.
