Note: Australia requires the donor dog to be tested for *Brucella canis* using one of the following test types (listed on the export health certificate):

- RSAT
- TAT
- IFAT

Only the standard versions of the tests listed above will be accepted.

The following tests are **not** approved:

- 2ME-RSAT
- 2ME-TAT
- AGID/AGID II
- Canine Brucella Multiplex Assay
- Brucella Slide Agglutination/AGID II combination test

Grace Period:

- Frozen canine semen consignments that have tested negative for *Brucella canis* using either the **2ME-RSAT** or **2ME-TAT** method, and meet all other import conditions, will be eligible for import into Australia prior to or on **31 January 2025**.
- From 1 February 2025, all frozen canine semen consignments must test negative for *Brucella canis* using a compliant test method to be eligible for import into Australia.
