

## **Lanolin (Wool Grease)**

Belgium requires facilities to be registered by APHIS for the export of lanolin (wool grease) [unless the importer has permission from Belgian authorities to import the Lanolin as an “intermediate product” accompanied by the Regulation (EU) 142/2011 as amended Chapter 20 importer declaration].

For information regarding how to become registered, facilities should contact the [VS Field Operations Veterinary Export Trade Services \(aka VS Service Center\)](#) office covering the area from where the product will be exported or is produced.

In addition to registration, each consignment must be accompanied by a VS Form 16-4 with the following text included in the Additional Declarations\* section:

In addition, both the container number and the batch number must be included in the IDENTIFICATION section of the VS Form 16-4.

\*Note- The following statement (from obsolete versions of the VS Form 16-4) may **not** be included in the ADDITIONAL DECLARATIONS section (or any part) of the VS Form 16-4:

“This is to certify that rinderpest, foot-and-mouth disease, classical swine fever, swine vesicular disease, African swine fever, and contagious bovine pleuropneumonia do not exist in the United States of America.”
