**USE SITES:** Hard nonporous surfaces inside and outside aircraft, as well as associated loading equipment including loading ramps.

**USE DIRECTIONS:** Surfaces must be cleaned prior to disinfection. Gross contamination, organic material, and debris must be removed via mechanical means like brushing (dry cleaning) and/or the use of water and soap or detergents (wet cleaning). *Benefect*® Botanical Daily Cleaner Disinfectant Spray should be applied per the EPA and State-approved container label. The disinfectant must be sprayed onto surfaces until moist and kept wet for the duration of 15 minutes, reapplying solution when necessary.
