### Certification Statements:

I, the undersigned USDA Accredited Veterinarian, certify to the following statements:

1. The eggs from which the day-old poultry were hatched were derived from flocks that were either born in the United States or have been resident in United States for the past six months, and during this time they have not had any contact with imported birds or poultry.

2. The day-old poultry in this consignment:

a. showed no clinical signs of avian influenza and other contagious diseases to which the species is susceptible on the day of inspection.

b. originate from a flock that is certified free of Salmonella pullorum.

c. originate from NPIP approved hatcheries or establishments.

d. Originate from establishments situated in zones free from official veterinary restrictions affecting poultry.

3. Highly pathogenic avian influenza (HPAI) and Newcastle disease (ND) have not occurred in or on any premises within a radius of 25 km of the premises of origin for a period of 28 days immediately prior to export.

4. With regards to Newcastle Disease, the day-old poultry showed no signs of Newcastle disease on the day of inspection; AND

[O] originate from a flock that has not been vaccinated for Newcastle Disease.

[O] have been vaccinated with an approved Newcastle Disease vaccine appropriate for their age group prior to dispatch.
