The poultry originated from poultry resident in the flock of origin which existed at the time of the tests of the flock referred to herein or from poultry that were natural increases of that flock or additions which originated from a flock serologically negative to a test for pullorum disease (Salmonella pullorum) and fowl typhoid (Salmonella gallinarum) within 12 months prior to entry to the flock of origin.

4. The poultry are in new, clean containers, or in used containers that have been cleaned and disinfected for the purpose of preventing the introduction of diseases.
