- Were not derived from regions or zones currently recognized by CFIA as affected by diseases of concern with the species of origin<sup>1</sup>
- The products or by-products covered by this certificate were not derived from animals slaughtered as part of a disease eradication program.
- 4) For products derived from swine, the animals from which the products were derived originate from commercial herds, which are considered as free of Aujeszky's Disease.
- 5) Bovinae<sup>2</sup> animals from which the products or by-products were derived were not stunned before slaughtering by means of injecting compressed air or gas into the cranial cavity, or by pithing;
- 6) Products or by-products were obtained from the carcasses of animals that were subjected to and passed ante-mortem inspection and were subjected to post-mortem inspection in a slaughterhouse supervised by the USDA-FSIS;
- 7) The animal products or by-products covered by this certificate do not contain any of the following tissues of any bovinae<sup>2</sup> animals: the skull, brain, trigeminal ganglia, eyes, palatine tonsils, spinal cord and dorsal root ganglia of bovinae<sup>2</sup> animals aged 30 months or older; and the distal ileum of bovinae<sup>2</sup> animals of all ages
- 8) The raw inedible products will be transported in a manner intended to prevent contamination and/or leakage of the products;
- 9) The raw inedible products or by-products have not been exposed to or comingled with any animal-origin materials that do not meet the requirements of this certificate;

  10) Shipping containers and all accompanying documentation are marked with the words "INEDIBLE" AND:
  - a) The name of the animal species for which the product/by-product is intended and the words "Food" or "Aliments pour." OR
  - b) The word "CONDEMNED" OR
  - c) "For medicinal purposes" or "for pharmaceutical purposes"
- 11) The products or by-products have either:
  - a) been denatured OR
  - b) have NOT been denatured as the nature of the commodity is not likely to be mistaken for an edible product

- For avian species including poultry: Highly Pathogenic Avian Influenza, Newcastle disease
- For ruminants: Contagious bovine pleuropneumonia; Foot-and-mouth disease (FMD); Lumpy skin disease; Peste des petits ruminants; Rift valley fever and Sheep pox and goat pox;
- For swine: African swine fever; Classical swine fever (Hog cholera); Foot and Mouth Disease; Swine vesicular disease;
