- 2. The aquatic animal(s) are of US origin or were legally imported and are not under any restriction by USDA-APHIS or intended for destruction or slaughter for disease control purposes.
- 3. To the best of my knowledge, the aquatic animals to be exported are not exposed to any other animals or water of lesser health status. Only water from this premise(s) of the same health status is used in this shipment.
- 4. Animals have been inspected within 7 days prior to export on the date of signature and appear to be free of the diseases in Section 4 and, to the best of my knowledge, exposure thereto.

Packaging and Shipping Information
