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**22. Zoosanitary Certification Statements:**  
I, the undersigned Veterinarian, duly authorized by the Government of Canada, hereby certify, after due enquiry and to the best of my knowledge and belief, that the animals described within this certificate meet the following requirements:

**COUNTRY LEVEL:**

22.1 The country\*, region\* or zone\* of Canada from which the animals originate and are exported, is officially free, in livestock, without vaccination, from the following contagious diseases:

22.1.1 foot-and-mouth disease;  
22.1.2 rinderpest;  
22.1.3 contagious bovine pleuropneumonia;  
22.1.4 Surra;

\* In the event of regionalization or zoning decisions by Canada for one of the listed disease in condition 22.1, the region or zone and use of this certificate for shipment of animals must be pre-approved by the Importing Country authorities prior to initiation of the pre-export isolation.

**AND**

**WITH REGARD TO BOVINE SPONGIFORM ENCEPHALOPATHY (BSE):**

22.2 The exported animals were born after 1st March 1999, which is date which is the date determined by APHIS to be the effective enforcement of a ruminant-to-ruminant feed ban regulations in Canada.

**THE ANIMALS EXPORTED:**

22.3 The animals were born in Canada or in the United States and were legally imported into Canada not more than forty (40) weeks prior to the expected date of export.

22.4 The feeder calves originating from the USA, and any Canadian origin feeder calves in contact with the USA origin animals, were under an "import quarantine" for the duration of their stay in Canada.

22.5 No feeder calves being exported were under quarantine for reasons relating to an active disease control or animal health investigation.

22.6 The animals exported:

22.6.1 Were born after the implementation of the ruminant feeding ban regulations in Canada as recognized by the USDA APHIS, which is March 1st, 1999.

22.6.2 Are identified in conformity with Canadian regulations, with a Canadian approved indicator (124 tag) or the USA equivalent (840 tag);

22.6.3 Were not animals under restrictions or identified to be killed under a national programme for the control or eradication of diseases.

22.6.4 were inspected by me and I found them to be free from any evidence of communicable disease and, as far as can be determined, they have not been exposed to any such disease during the preceding 60 days. Based upon information provided by the exporter, the feeder calves will be transported by truck from the point of entry in the U.S., along the following route:

**Notes:**  
Feeder calf" definition as recorded in the Import Reference Document is a male calf of the species *Bos taurus* that is imported into Canada from the United States for the purpose of feeding and subsequent slaughter not later than forty (40) weeks after importation and is not less than nine (9) days of age and not more than twenty-one (21) days of age at the time of its importation into Canada.

The certificate is valid for 30 days from signature date, including transportation period.
