<p>Certification Statements:</p> <p>I hereby certify that following due enquiry and to the best of my knowledge and belief, the commercial birds covered under this health certificate comply with the following statements:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The birds were not exposed to active cases of Newcastle disease on the premises where they were kept, or on adjoining premises, during the ninety (90) days immediately preceding export. 2. The birds were not exposed to active cases of Highly Pathogenic Avian Influenza (HPAI) on the premises where they were kept, or on adjoining premises, during the twenty-eight (28) days immediately preceding export. 3. The birds do not originate from, and have not transited through, a control zone established by the Canadian Food Inspection Agency (CFIA) due to outbreaks of Newcastle disease or HPAI and are not currently under quarantine nor have any restrictions to their movement. The exporter has been advised that this condition must continue to be met during transportation from the premises of origin to the United States. 4. The birds were examined within the thirty (30) days immediately preceding the date of export and presented no evidence of communicable disease of poultry. 5. The birds were not vaccinated against any H5 or H7 subtype of avian influenza. 6. The birds were either: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> A. <input type="checkbox"/> Not vaccinated against Newcastle disease (avian paramyxovirus). OR B. <input type="checkbox"/> Vaccinated against Newcastle disease at least twenty-one (21) days prior to export, using vaccines that do not contain any velogenic strains of Newcastle disease virus. 7. The exporter has been advised that the birds must not be commingled with birds or poultry of a lesser health status than specified on this certificate between the time of veterinary inspection and arrival at the port of exit. 8. The exporter has been advised that the birds must be placed in new or appropriately sanitized shipping containers at the premises where they are kept prior to movement for export.
