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Certification Statements:

1. The United States is free of foot-and-mouth disease.
2. At the time of semen collection, the semen donors were kept in an infectious bovine rhinotracheitis/infectious pustular vulvovaginitis (IBR/IPV) free herd as defined in the World Organisation for Animal Health (WOAH) Terrestrial Code.
3. The semen is from a semen collection center (SCC) that is officially free from Bovine Brucellosis and Bovine Tuberculosis as defined by the WOAH Terrestrial Code.
4. The semen was collected from donor bulls which:
 - a. Were born after the date of the enforcement of a ban on feeding of ruminant protein to ruminants.
 - b. Originate from a herd where Bovine Spongiform Encephalopathy (BSE) has not been confirmed for a period of at least seven (7) years.
 - c. Are not the progeny of a BSE suspect or confirmed female.
 - d. Are identified with a permanent identification system which allows them to be traced back to the dam and herd of origin.
 - e. Have been continually resident for a period of at least two (2) months at an officially approved semen production center in the United States.
5. The donor bulls were tested within six (6) months of collection of the semen for export to the Cayman Islands with negative results for the following diseases:
 - a. Bluetongue: using a competitive enzyme-linked immunosorbent assay (ELISA) or Polymerase Chain Reaction (PCR) testing on whole blood and/or semen.
 - b. Leptospirosis: By serological testing to detect antibody to the leptospira virus group--such as leptospira competition enzyme-linked immunosorbent assay (ELISA) or the leptospira agar gel immunodiffusion (AGID) test--performed between 28 and 60 days after final semen collection, with negative results.
 - c. Trichomoniasis: using a competitive enzyme-linked immunosorbent assay (ELISA).
6. The tank/container must be new and have a numbered, tamper-proof seal.

7. All equipment used to collect, handle, wash, freeze and store the semen must have been new or sterilized prior to use.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

1. No Bovine Semen shall be imported into the Cayman Islands except that such semen is imported directly from Australia, New Zealand, Great Britain, Northern Ireland, the Republic of Ireland, Canada, the United States of America or CARICOM States.

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Certification Statements:

2. Semen must be accompanied by an Import Permit from the Department of Agriculture, Cayman Islands and a copy of the permit must accompany the shipment.

3. Semen imported into the Cayman Islands must be accompanied by a health certificate issued within 14 days of arrival.
