### Commodity-specific information:

For pet foods certified with the new protocol (after June 15, 2020), poultry ingredients must be heat-treated or sourced from States other than Alabama, Alaska, Arkansas, California, Colorado, Florida, Georgia, Idaho, Illinois, Indiana, Iowa, Kansas, Maryland, Massachusetts, Michigan, Minnesota, Mississippi, Missouri, Montana, Nebraska, Nevada, New Hampshire, New Jersey, New York, North Carolina, North Dakota, Ohio, Oregon, Pennsylvania, South Dakota, Tennessee, Texas, Utah, Virginia, Washington, and Wisconsin.

For rendered poultry and feather meals, the manufacturing facility must be located more than 50 km from the center of an active HPAI control zone. A control zone is considered “active” until they meet the criteria for recovery of free status as described in the WOHAT Terrestrial Animal Health Code. Exporters should contact their [VS Service Center](#) with any questions regarding the specifics of this zone.

## China – Important information regarding trade bans and other restrictions

**BSE:** China has banned bovine products from the United States due to BSE since 2003. Some restrictions were lifted in 2020, but products other than hides, milk and milk products, protein-free fats and their products, bone-based dicalcium phosphate (without protein or fat), industrial gelatin and collagen processed entirely from leather or skin, or products with negotiated protocols as listed on the IRegs are not eligible. Exporters should contact their Service Center with any questions about the eligibility of their bovine origin product.
