## Export of Gelatin to China for Technical Use

In order for a facility to be eligible to export gelatin to China, APHIS must inspect and approve the facility. The inspection will verify that the gelatin is derived from animals that passed antemortem inspection at slaughter. FSIS will not approve animals for slaughter that have clinical signs of nervous disorders. The facility should be inspected yearly to confirm they meet this criteria.

The following statements must be typed on the VS Form 16-4 in the ADDITIONAL DECLARATIONS section:

This is to certify that rinderpest, foot-and-mouth disease, classical swine fever, swine vesicular disease, African swine fever, and contagious bovine pleuropneumonia do not exist in the United States of America.

The gelatin is derived from animals that have passed ante-mortem inspection at slaughter and were found free of clinical signs of nervous disorders.

The facility where the gelatin was manufactured is approved for export by APHIS.

No additional statements should be added.
