Effective April 30, 2024 Great Britain is requiring a new commercial dogs, cats, and ferret's health certificate <u>GBHC640</u>. This certificate is now on the UK Pet Website and can be used immediately. <u>GBHC640</u> is replacing GBHC157. No other pet certificate will be replaced at this time.

## Certificate guidance:

- Please disregard boxes I.8 and I.10
- I.11 if the owner is not a commercial institution, enter the name and address at Place of Origen, but enter N/A for Approval number.
- I.12 Place of Destination can be used only when the consignment is destined to institute or bodies, or when the final destination is different from box I.5, for example with rescue pets.
- I.15 Enter the airline and flight number. You may add the Airway Bill number, if available, but it's not required.
- I.16 Give the name of the BCP or the BCP identification code or both assigned here.
- I.17 Transporter- Please provide details of who is responsible for transporting the animal to their destination in Great Britain. Enter commercial live animal transporter OR if an animal is being transported by its owner and is not being moved for commercial purposes (e.g. moving home), enter the consignee details and N/A for the approval number.
- o I.18 Description of Commodity, write in dogs, or cats, or ferrets as applicable
- I.25 Commodity certified for:
  - Select "Other" if EITHER the animal is personally owned but the owner is not traveling withing 5 days before or after the pet OR if the animal is not a personally owned pet (i.e., they will transfer to a new owner in Great Britain). This includes animals purchased from U.S. breeders/adopted from U.S. shelters that are not traveling with their new owners from the United States to Great Britain.
  - Select "Pets" if there are more than 5 personally owned pets OR if the animal(s) on the certificate is/are NOT intended to transfer ownership (be sold/adopted out/given away to someone in Great Britain).
- I.28 Enter the three name of the species located in the notes section. Also, select from dropdown if the animal has a transponder or tattoo.
- AH/A103 Animal Requirements [Tapeworm for Dogs Only]
  - Please select from one of the either/or statements saying that the dog was either treated or not treated for tapeworm.
- The new GBHC640 certificate does not have pre-populated line-outs, please select what is applicable to the pets' circumstances.
