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**Certification Statements:**

1. I certify that the animals described have been inspected by me on this date, within 14 days of export, and appear to be free of any infectious or contagious diseases and, to the best of my knowledge, exposure thereto, which would endanger the animals or other animals or would endanger public health.
2. The animals were vaccinated for rabies at the age of 12 weeks or older with an inactivated vaccine at least 21 days but not longer than 12 months to 36 months (as registered by the manufacturer) prior to departure.
3. The animals were treated for endo and ectoparasites as listed in (a.) and (b.). The date and product used are listed in the corresponding table below. After the treatment, the animals were kept protected from obvious exposure to endo and ectoparasites.
  - a. The animal was treated for ectoparasites within 14 days prior to departure with an approved systemic/oral or topical ectoparasite product as instructed by the manufacturer, that has a long lasting persistent efficacy of at least 28 days,; and
  - b. The animal was treated for endo-parasites within 14 days prior to departure with an approved product.
