The U.S. Department of Commerce, National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA) is the primary agency responsible for providing certification for seafood, fish meal, and fish oil. The FDA may also certify some seafood products, such as blocks of frozen fish.

Exporters seeking certification of dead shrimp for human consumption containing no terrestrial animal ingredients should contact the NOAA Seafood Inspection Program Regional Office regarding certification of this product.
