1. Birds covered by this certificate do not originate from flocks nor had contact with any birds or poultry originating in a control zone established by state/Federal animal health authorities due to outbreaks of Newcastle disease or Highly Pathogenic Avian Influenza (HPAI).
2. The birds were born and raised in the United States, or legally imported.
3. During the 30 days prior to export, the birds have been isolated from other birds of a lesser or unknown health status.
4. During the 3 months prior to export, the birds, as well as flock of origin, did not have any diagnosed cases of Infectious Bursal Disease, Avian Encephalomyelitis, Marek's Disease, Infectious Bronchitis, Infectious Layngotracheitis, Chronic Respiratory Disease (*Mycoplasma gallisepticum*).
