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Certification Statements:

1. The crustaceans originate from an establishment of origin that is registered and under the supervision of the Competent Authority for Animal Health in the United States (USDA APHIS).
2. The establishment/premises of origin is free from evidence of the following pathogens to which the species is considered susceptible per the World Organisation for Animal Health (WOAH) [delete as appropriate]. Monitoring and surveillance systems at the premises of origin are in accordance with the procedures described in the Manual of Diagnostic Tests for Aquatic Animals from the WOAH. Premises freedom is based on the absence of clinical, laboratory, and epidemiological evidence of the pathogens of concern for a minimum of 2 years.
  - a. IHNV (Infectious hypodermal and haematopoietic necrosis virus)
  - b. WSSV (white spot syndrome virus)
  - c. TSV (Taura syndrome virus)
  - d. YHV (yellow head virus)
  - e. AHPND (Acute hepatopancreatic necrosis disease)
  - f. IMNV (infectious myonecrosis virus)
  - g. NHP (Necrotizing hepatopancreatitis)
  - h. SHIV/DIV1 (Shrimp Hemocyte Iridescent virus/Decapod iridescent virus 1)
  - i. MrNV/WD (Macrobrachium rosenbergii nodavirus/White tail disease)
3. All testing required for the animals to qualify for export is performed by an APHIS-approved laboratory.
4. There have been no cases of the following pathogens in the establishment of origin within the past 2 years prior to export: MoV (Mourilyan virus); BP (Baculovirus); MBV (Monodon baculovirus); HPV (Hepatopancreatic parvovirus); EHP (Enterocytozoon hepatopenaei); and CMNV (Covert mortality nodavirus).
5. The premises of origin has not experienced any unexplained mortality events within the last 6 months prior to shipment.
6. The crustaceans to be exported were visually examined within 96 hours prior to shipment, and there were no signs of any contagious diseases, and to the best of my knowledge, they were not exposed to infectious agents of the diseases of concern.
7. The container and packing materials in which the crustaceans are transported are new and cleaned.
