## Part II. Certification

I, the undersigned official veterinarian, declare that I have read and understood Regulation (EC) No 1069/2009 and in particular Article 9 thereof, and Commission Regulation (EU) No 142/2011, and in particular Annex XIV, Chapter II thereof, and certify that the processed manure, the derived products from processed manure and the guano from bats described above:

- **II.1** come from a plant for the manufacture of products for purposes other than feeding to farmed animals, a biogas plant or a composting plant approved by the competent authority of the third country meeting the special conditions laid down in Regulation (EC) No 1069/2009 and in Regulation (EU) No 142/2011;
- **II.2** have been subjected to:
  - <sup>(1)</sup>*either* [a heat treatment process of at least 70 °C for at least 60 minutes;]
  - (1) or [an equivalent treatment validated and authorised by Great Britain in accordance with the specific conditions laid down in Regulation (EC) No 1069/2009 and in Regulation (EU) No 142/2011 as follows:

- **II.4** are securely enclosed in:
  - (a) well-sealed and insulated containers; or
  - (b) properly sealed packs (plastic bags or 'big bags').
