(a) for at least 12 months before dispatch, has been free from the following diseases:

^(*)[classical swine fever; and African swine fever; and]

^(*)[rinderpest; and]

(b) ^(*)[has been free for at least 12 months before dispatch from foot-and-mouth disease and where, for 12 months before dispatch, no vaccination has been carried out against foot-and-mouth disease;]

AH/A751 Animal requirements

have been obtained from animals that:

^(*)~~**EITHER** [were slaughtered and their carcasses are fit for human consumption in accordance with GB law;]~~

^(*)**OR** [were slaughtered in a slaughterhouse, after undergoing ante-mortem inspection, and were considered fit, for slaughter for human consumption in accordance with GB law;]

AH/P015 Product requirements (segregation)

have undergone all precautions to avoid contamination with pathogenic agents;
