References to Great Britain in this certificate include Channel Islands and Isle of Man.

Date of loading

Imports of these animals shall not be allowed when the animals were loaded either prior to the date of authorisation for exportation to Great Britain of the third country, territory or part thereof referred to in boxes reference I.7 and I.8, or during a period where restrictive measures have been adopted by Great Britain against imports of these animals from this third country, territory or part thereof.

AH/A614A Animal requirements (parasite treatment)

Parasite treatment is not compulsory, but if the animals have been treated, information on the product(s) used and the active ingredients must be filled in.

AH/A616 Animal requirements

- (b) Please note that according to retained Regulation No 1/2005 animals will be checked by authorities to verify if they are fit to continue the journey after entry into GB. In case the requirements are not fulfilled, the animals need to be unloaded and further measures taken.
