#### **Certification Statements:**

I, the undersigned USDA Accredited Veterinarian, certify to the following statements:

a. The United States has been free of foot and mouth disease (FMD) without vaccination, for a period of at least twenty-four (24) months immediately prior to the date of exportation of the animals.

b. The United States has been free of classical swine fever (CSF) and African swine fever (ASF) for a period of at least twenty-four (24) months immediately prior to the date of exportation of the animals.

c. The farms of origin of the animals for export are under the oversight of a USDA  $\ensuremath{\mathsf{Accredited}}$  Veterinarian.

d. The animals for export are physically sound, in good health, and are free from clinical signs of swine flu, swine brucellosis, anthrax, pseudorabies (Aujeszky's disease), porcine reproductive and respiratory syndrome (PRRS), porcine epidemic diarrhea (PED) and leptospirosis.

e. The farms of origin of the animals for export have had no clinical cases of any of the following diseases for the twenty-four (24) months immediately prior to the date of export: swine flu, anthrax and leptospirosis.

f. The farms of origin of the animals for export have had no clinical cases of any of the following diseases for the twenty-four (24) months immediately prior to the date of export OR the animals for export were tested negative during isolation using WOAH approved test methods, as listed below: pseudorabies (Aujeszky's disease), swine brucellosis, transmissible gastroenteritis (TGE), porcine reproductive and respiratory syndrome (PRRS), porcine epidemic diarrhea (PED).

g. The farms of origin of the animals for export have had no clinical cases of trichinellosis or porcine cysticercosis for the twenty-four (24) months immediately prior to the date of export, and after due inquiry I am satisfied that the animals for export have never been fed garbage at any time.
