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Certification Statements:

I, the undersigned USDA Accredited Veterinarian, certify to the following statements:

1. The breeding DOC were kept in a country, 10 km zone, or compartment free from infection with High Pathogenicity Avian Influenza (HPAI) viruses in poultry since they were hatched.
2. The breeding DOC originated from a country, 10 km zone, or compartment within the United States that is officially free from HPAI in poultry according to the WOAHP Terrestrial Animal Health Code, and does not have a vaccination program for this disease.
3. The breeding DOC originated from establishment(s)/farm(s) where, within a radius of 6 kilometres, there have been no confirmed cases nor have there been any reports of low pathogenic avian influenza in poultry according to the WOAHP Code during the last 6 months prior to shipments.
4. The establishment(s)/farm(s) of origin must be officially registered with the USDA National Poultry Improvement Plan (NPIP). The details (names, addresses, and NPIP numbers) of the establishment(s)/farm(s) are provided on this certificate.
5. The poultry was derived from parent flocks which had been kept in an avian influenza-free establishment for at least 14 days prior to and the time of the collection of the eggs.
6. The farm(s) from which the eggs or DOC were produced must be under routine inspection by a USDA accredited veterinarian, and within the 6 (six) months preceding the inspection, there were no evidence of clinical symptom of all infectious disease including: Newcastle Disease (ND), Fowl Pox, Fowl Cholera, Fowl Typhoid, Infectious Bronchitis (IB), Infectious Laryngotracheitis (ILT), Infectious Synovitis, Infectious Bursal Disease (IBD), Egg Drop Syndrome, Pullorum, Typhoid Disease, Ornithosis, Marek's Disease, Lymphoid Leucosis, Mycoplasmosis, Chronic Respiratory Disease (CRD), Swollen Head Syndrome, Chicken Anaemia Agent, Avian Nephritis, Leucocytozoonosis, Infectious Coryza, Avian Spirochaetosis, Avian Encephalomyelitis, Avian Salmonellosis and Tuberculosis.
7. The parent flocks were either U.S. Salmonella Monitored (for chicken) or U.S. Sanitation Monitored (turkey) according to NPIP guidelines. Salmonella testing indicated negative results.
8. Disinfection of hatching eggs and fumigation of hatchery equipment were routinely carried out prior to hatching.
9. The parent flock of the breeding DOC has been vaccinated against Marek's disease.
10. The parent flock of the breeding DOC may have been vaccinated against coccidiosis either at day one (1) or day three (3) with the method of vaccination that has been

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approved by DGLAHS.
