There were 9 surveillance inspections conducted at 8 different sites for a total of 45 fish sampled this month. Samples are targeted to moribund and fresh mortalities. The water temperatures continued to increase in response to warmer air temperatures. Routine harvest was completed, as was stocking of new smolts. The bay with Category 2b sites was emptied of fish. All other sites with fish in the water remained Category 1 and were scheduled for monthly sampling.
