I, the undersigned veterinarian, hereby certify that the animals described above comply with the following requirements:

1. The animals originate from a facility under the oversight of the competent authority of the exporting country.
2. The population from which the animals are exported are cultured bass only (Morone spp. and their hybrids)
3. The premises of origin is free from evidence of infectious pancreatic necrosis (IPN) and viral hemorrhagic septicemia (VHS) based on the absence of clinical, laboratory, and epidemiological evidence of these pathogens for a minimum of 2 years.
4. All testing was conducted at a laboratory officially accredited by the competent authority.
5. The population from which the animals are exported is not intended for destruction or slaughter for disease control purposes, and the premises of origin is not under any restriction by the competent authority.
6. The population from which the animals are exported has not experienced any unexplained morbidity or mortality events during the 90 days prior to shipment.
7. The animals to be exported were visually examined within 7 days prior to loading. During examination, the animals showed no signs of contagious diseases and, to the best of my knowledge, were not exposed to infectious agents of concern.
