Collagen Powder (Poultry-Origin)

Collagen powder intended for animal consumption:

Japan's Ministry of Agriculture, Forestry, and Fisheries (MAFF) prohibits the import of collagen powder intended for animal consumption.

Collagen powder (poultry-origin) intended for human consumption:

If the powder is packaged ready for retail, MAFF will allow entry into Japan as long as the product is accompanied by a VS Form 16-4 with the following additional declarations [The "This is to certify that rinderpest, foot-and-mouth disease, classical swine fever, swine vesicular disease, African swine fever, and contagious bovine pleuropneumonia do not exist in the United States of America" sentence should only appear once on the VS Form 16-4 (it was pre-printed on versions preceding the JUL 2022 version). If the JUL 2022 version of the VS Form 16-4 is utilized, it should be the first sentence in the ADDITIONAL DECLARATION area.]:

"This is to certify that rinderpest, foot-and-mouth disease, classical swine fever, swine vesicular disease, African swine fever, and contagious bovine pleuropneumonia do not exist in the United States of America."

"The product described below originates from poultry and is intended for human consumption." Japan's Ministry of Health, Labor, and Welfare (MHLW) may have additional standards that the powder must meet. (APHIS does not provide certification of these standards.)

If the powder is not packaged ready for retail, MAFF prohibits the import into Japan.
